# Team RGS - School Sport

At RGS Guildford Dubai we pride ourselves on the sporting opportunities that we offer for all pupils through games lessons, house matches and representative fixtures against other schools. Representative fixtures are a wonderful way for pupils to showcase the RGS learning habits and values and what it means to be an RGS pupil through sport. These opportunities will also allow pupils to challenge their skills and techniques under pressure.

**Selection for Team RGS is completed through curriculum games lessons for football, netball, rugby, cricket and rounders. In these lessons** pupils are streamed into training groups to suit their needs and experience level with the termly sport. The training squads are fluid and are reviewed weekly based on pupil performance and progress. Similarly, the selection for the team changes from fixture to fixture. Participation in the after school ECA programme does not factor into the selection of representative teams for these sports.

Selection for Team RGS basketball will be based on performance in curriculum PE lessons and attendance to before school training.

It is important to be aware that these fixtures will take place after school and may clash with ECAs. Therefore, if your son/daughter would like to be considered for the school sports teams it is advised that you avoid placing them into paid activities on their age groups fixture afternoon. **We cannot offer a refund if pupils miss a paid ECA for a sports fixture.**

### Where do I collect my child from after their ECA?

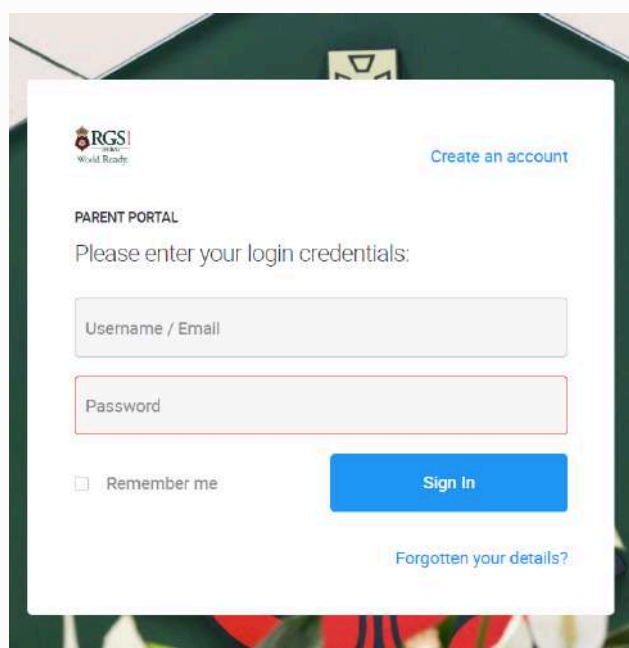
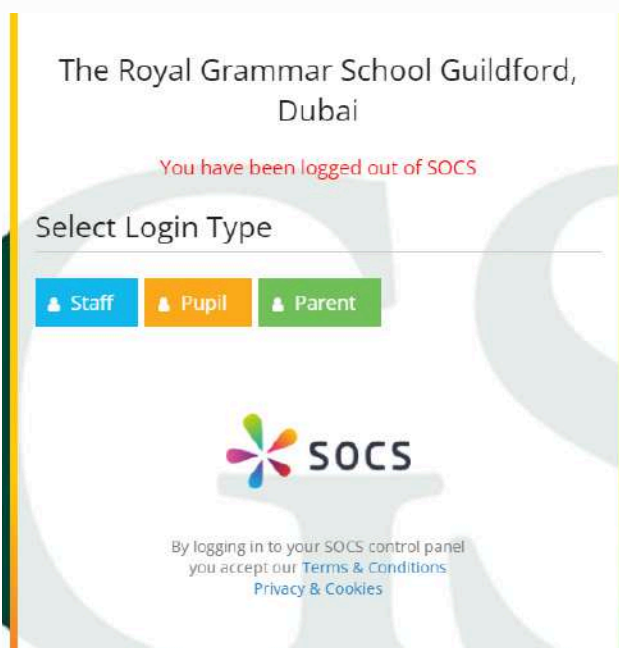
4. Enter your iSAMS Parent Portal Username and Password

## Note for android calendar users

Add the calendar to the Google account assigned to your Android device:

Log into the Google Calendar website using the account assigned to your Android device, then from top-menu click "More > Calendar".

On the left, next to "Other calendars," click **Add** + > and then "From URL".

Enter the calendar's address.

Click "Add calendar". The calendar appears on the left, under "Other calendars."

Tip: It might take up to 12 hours for changes to show in your Google Calendar.

You will see the calendar subscription appear under "Other Calendars".

Confirm that the subscription is working by verifying that events are appearing in the calendar.

Configure you Android device to sync to your Google calendar:

Go into you device's Calendar app, in the settings make sure your Google account is checked, then select 'Sync Now'.

You may need to select the Google account calendar, then under "Other calendars" check the subscribed calendars the Android device is to sync with (by default, the "Other calendars" may not be checked).
